10/12/1957 - 6/17/2016

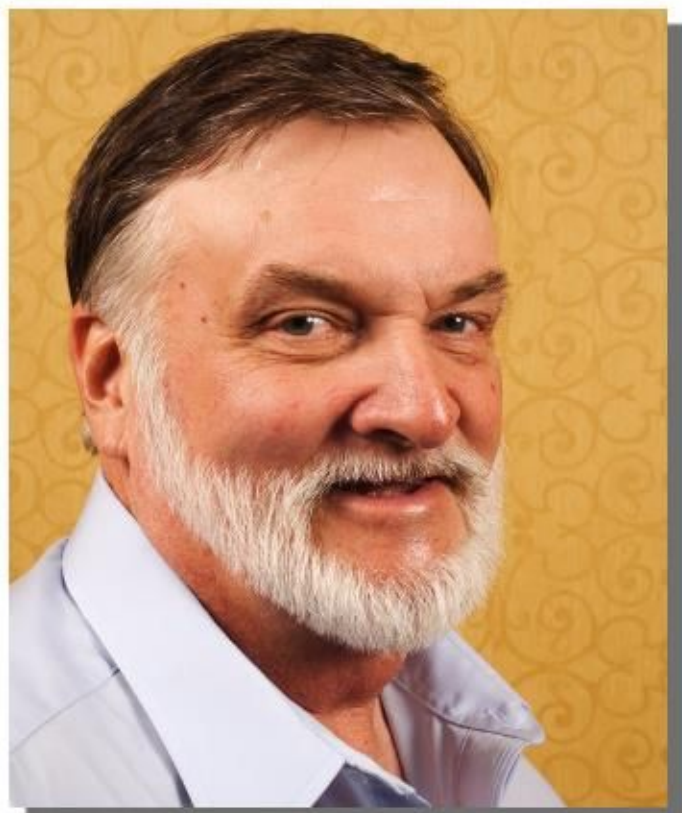

# RICHARD VONDERHEIDE

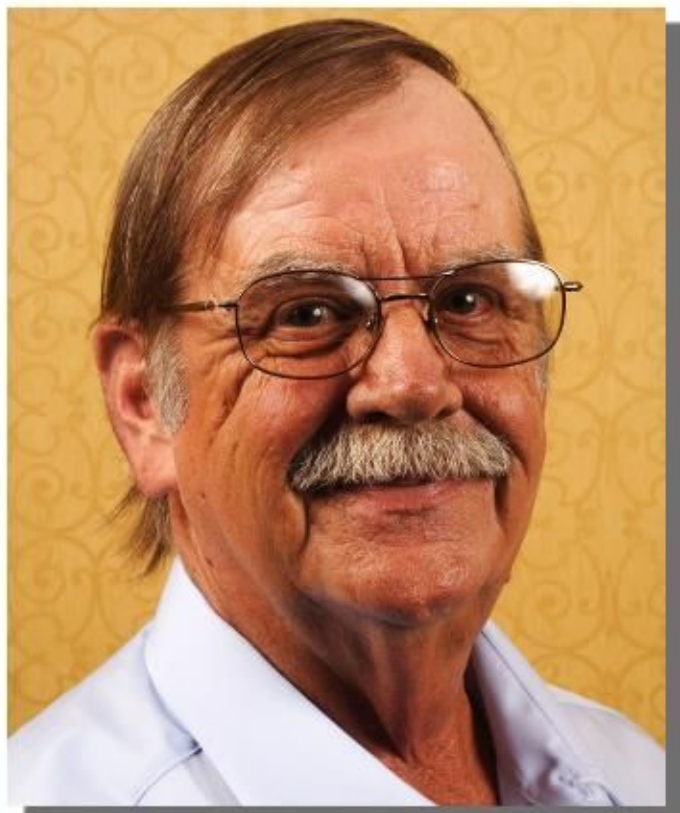
1/11/1945 - 1/27/2017

# JOSE SALAS

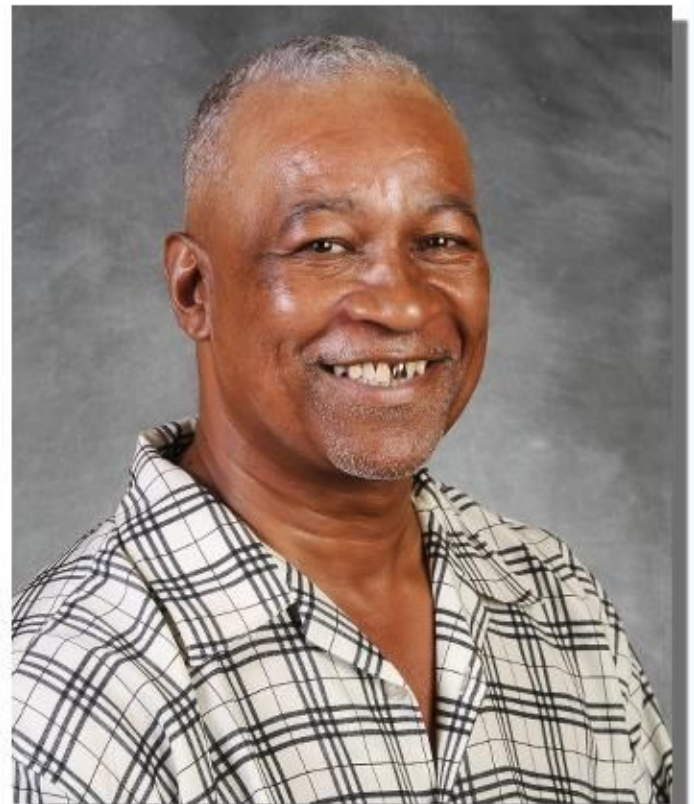

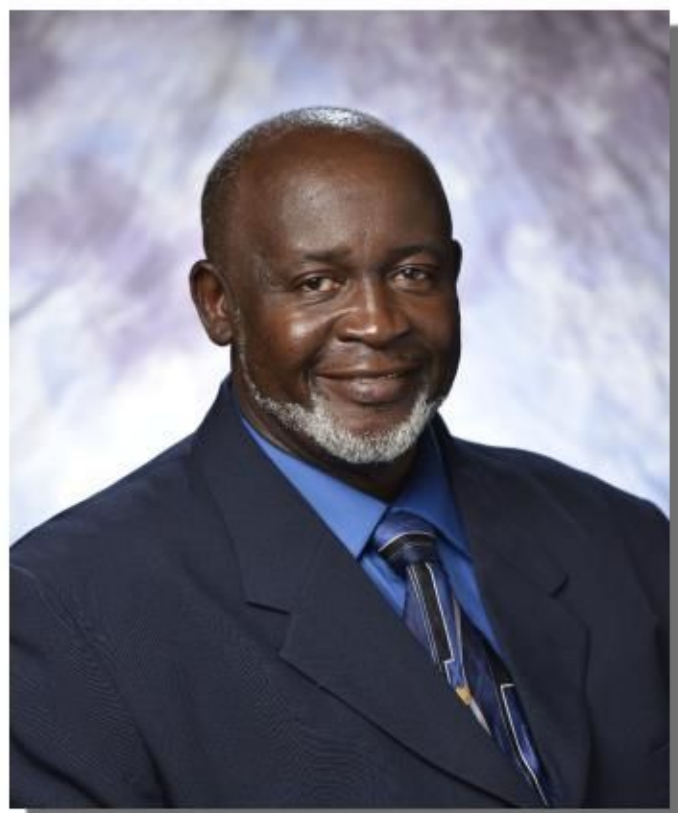
# VICTOR RIVERS

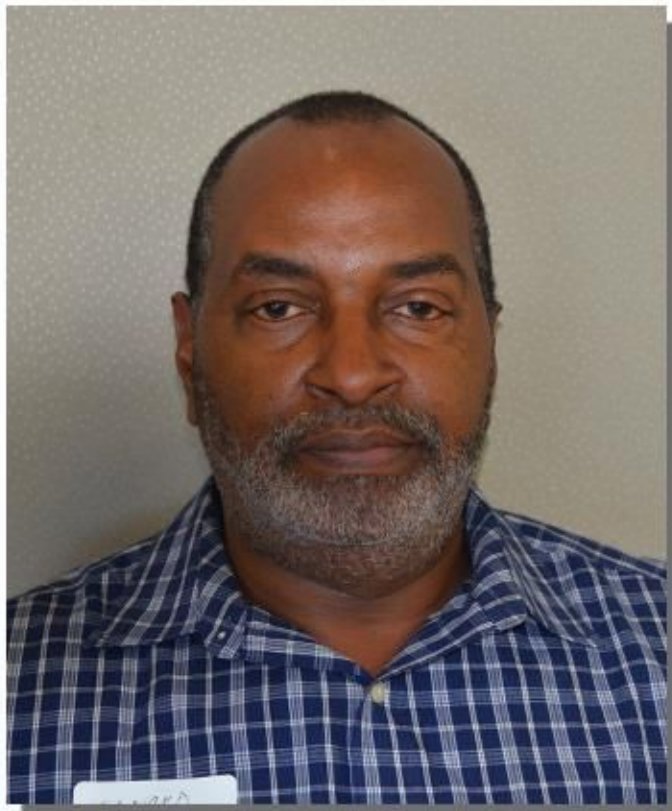

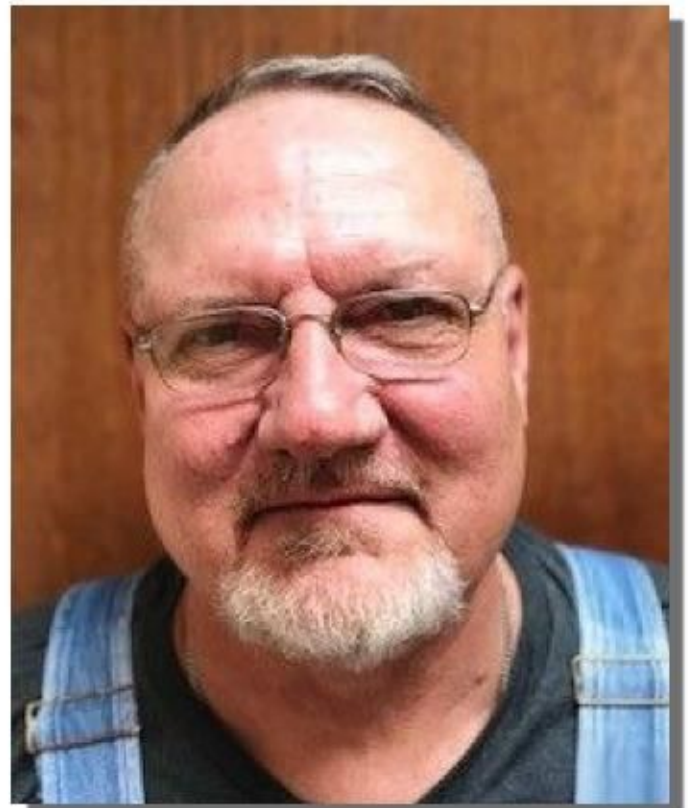
## BILLY LEONARD

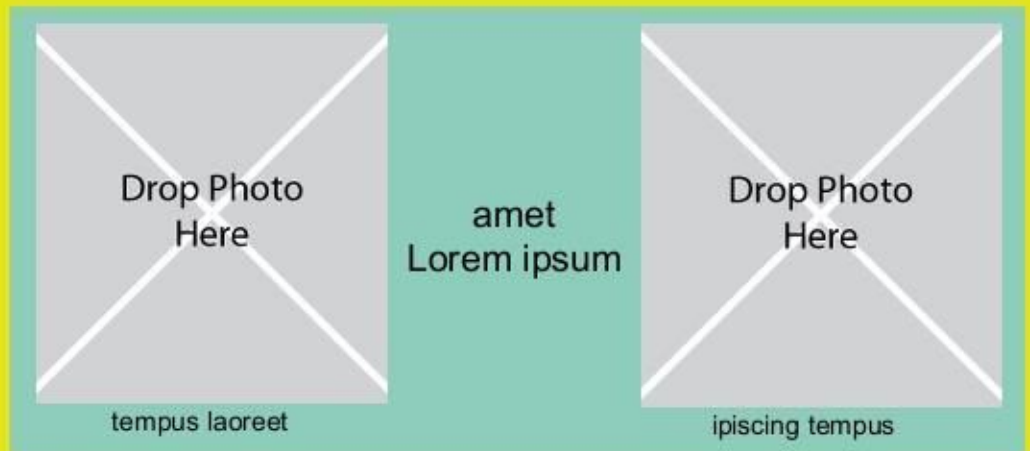
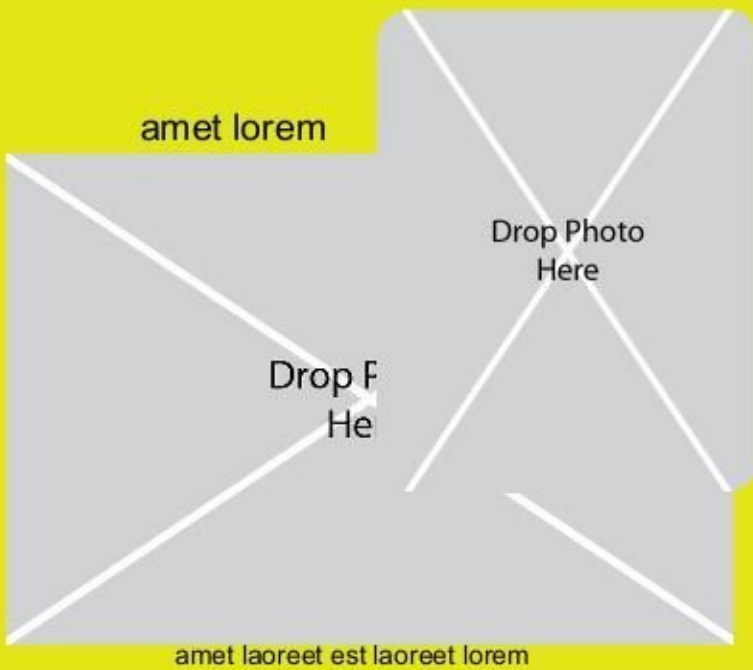
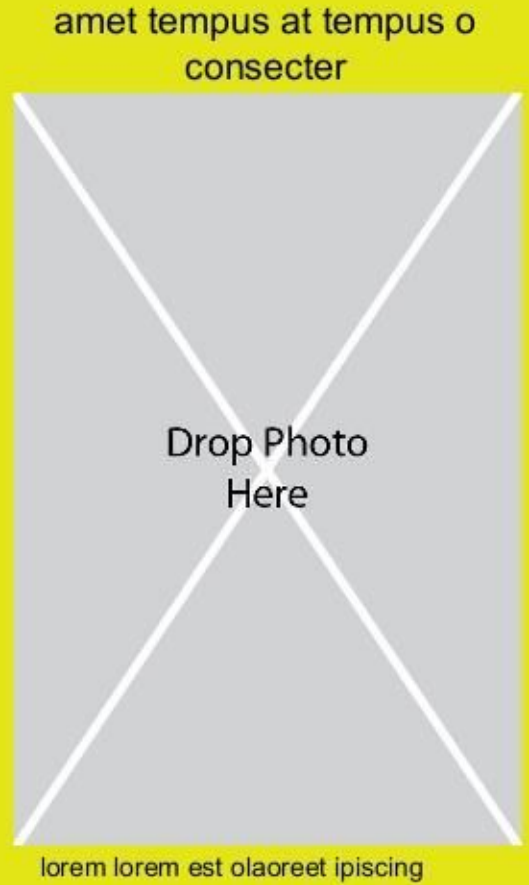
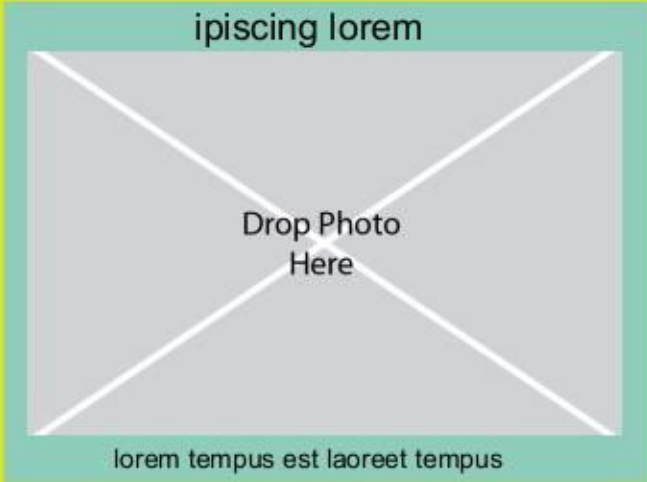
## JASON WRIGHT

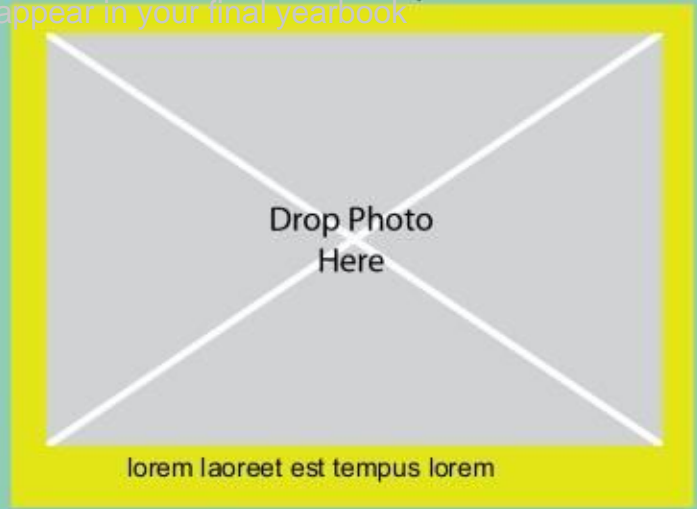
